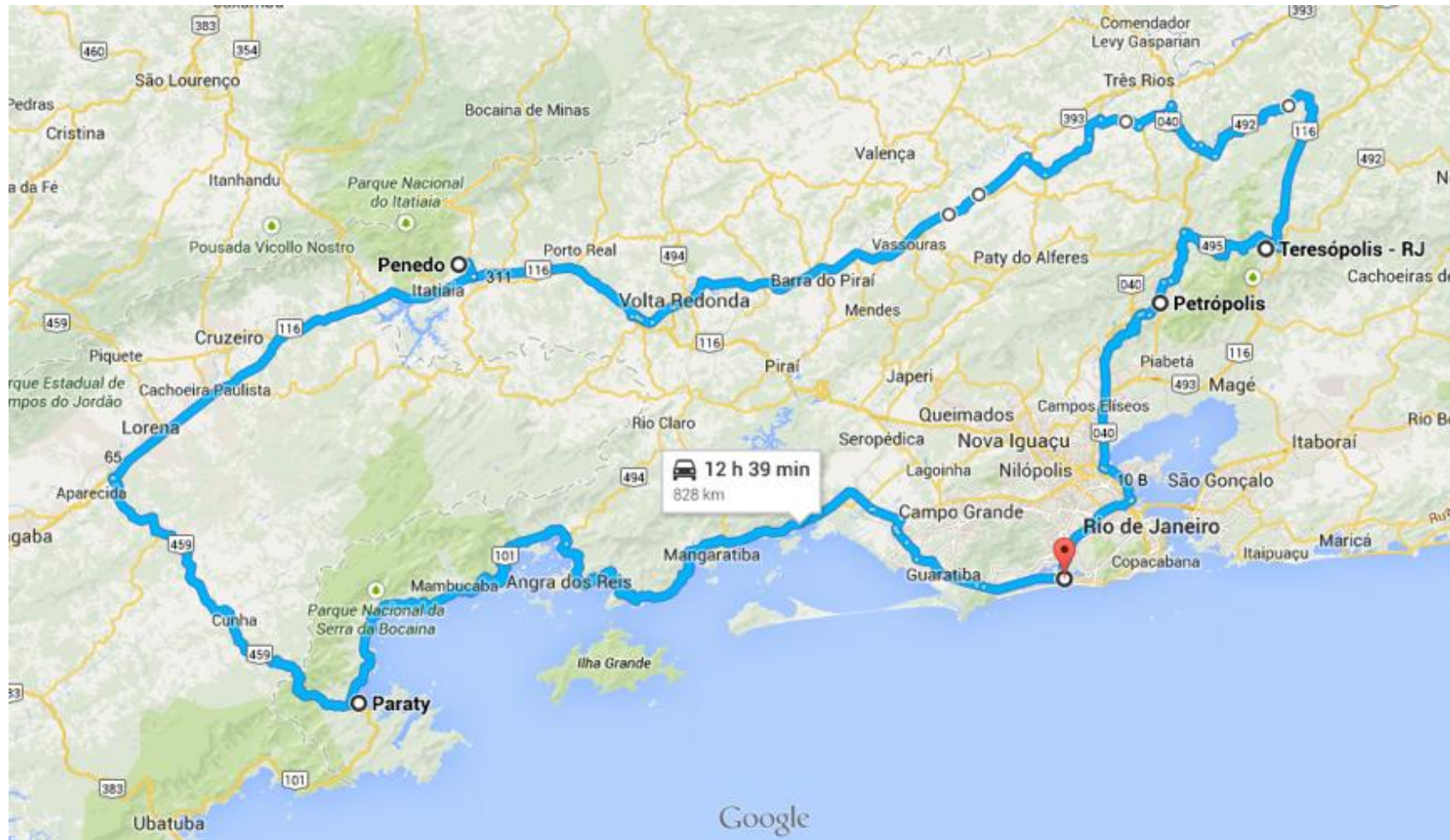

Day 1 : Rio de Janeiro Arrival

Rio de Janeiro was the capital of Brazil until 1960. Often called Cidade Maravilhosa (The Marvellous City) Rio de Janeiro is world renowned for its breathtaking landscapes and location, nestled between lush, green mountains and crystal clear seas. Rio is one of the most culturally and economically prominent cities in Brazil and features some of the country's most famous tourist attractions such as Pão de Açúcar (Sugarloaf Mountain), Corcovado (Christ the Redeemer statue), and the iconic beaches of Copacabana and Ipanema. The city is full of energy and rhythm, and the locals of Rio, Cariocas, are known for their carefree spirit and charm. Whether you are looking to experience Carnival, relax in a naturally stunning environment, or enjoy all the luxuries of a cosmopolitan city, Rio de Janeiro has it all! This is a resting day from your trip.



Day 2 : Rio de Janeiro - Petropolis – Teresópolis

85 mi / 150 km

Enjoy your continental breakfast and pick-up your chosen bike. We will guide you on a quick tour around Rio riding around Floresta da Tijuca, the biggest Urban Florest in the World stopping by Corcovado (Christ the Redeemer statue), considered on of the seven wonders of the new world. Departure to Petropolis and Teresópolis, overnight at Teresópolis..




Day 3 : Teresópolis - Penedo

After breakfast and a few breathtaking views at Teresópolis such as "The God's finger" you can take the road all the way to Penedo on the other side of Rio State, also on the mountain side located on the corner of Itatiaia's National Park . The park is part of the Mantiqueira mountain range, and home to Brazil's third highest mountain, Pico das Agulhas Negras, which stands at 2,878 meters. The park attracts bird watchers from all over the world with its 350 species of birds. Other attractions include hiking and rock climbing.

The low area of the park is much closer to the city of Itatiaia and has many waterfalls, such as Véu da Noiva with 45 meters. The low area has also a Natural History museum. Itatiaia means "many-pointed rock" in the Tupi language.

Day 4 : Penedo - Paraty	125 mi / 200 km
<p>One of the best places to stay near the park is the small village of Penedo. it has an european style and full of nature and waterfalls all around. Founded by the Finns, this is where Brazilians were introduced to the concept of a Finnish sauna. The village retained its Alpine scenery, and European charm. Typical handcraft, rustic carpets, chocolate factories and Finnish chutney are some of the products you will find for sale at local shops. In the morning after breakfast, you can make a quick tour at Visconde de Maua, charming city just 30 km away from Penedo and then head toward Paraty.</p>	

Day 5 : Paraty	0 mi / 0 km
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Paraty Brazil has long been considered one of Brazil's historical, hidden gems that has become extremely appealing for tourists to visit. Whether you want to soak up the sun along the golden coast, or explore the quaint, historical town there is plenty to see and do.

After breakfast, we will take a schooner tour. Passengers will embark on a schooner that sails to several of the most beautiful beaches and islands in the bay of Paraty, all surrounded by dense rainforest. After sailing for roughly 40 minutes, the schooner makes three stops of about one hour each for sunbathing, swimming, and snorkeling. Although the exact locations tend to vary with each tour, depending on weather conditions and to avoid the crowds, the islands generally included in the tour are: Comprida, Algodão, Cotia, Praia Vermelha and also the beaches of Lulas, and Saco da Velha amongst many others.

Duration: approximately 5 hours

Lunch is not included

The tour includes snorkeling equipment (masks and snorkels) as well as fruit for the passengers.



Day 6 : Paraty - Rio de Janeiro

156 mi / 250 km

After breakfast, take your time back to Rio. Enjoy the sun, go for a walk or just relax before riding back. Paraty has a lot of activities, things to do and see and you can take your time doing it. No rush to get back.
